Once your application has been accepted by the committee you will be given options regarding fee payment.

Why join?

Annual membership of the RSCDS Sydney Branch costs \$45 (\$30 for under 25s).

Members can attend classes, workshops, social dances, residential weekends and Winter Schools, often with a member's discount. Members may apply for financial assistance to attend workshops and courses. The Branch aims to run four socials, a ball, three workshops, a residential weekend, occasional short term courses, plus at least one day of dance each year. There is a monthly branch E-newsletter to keep you informed of upcoming events. The newsletter, SNIB, is issued three times a year.

Membership of the Sydney Branch includes membership of the Royal Scottish Country Dance Society based in Edinburgh, Scotland. Each member receives 'Scottish Country Dancer', the Society magazine, twice a year and can subscribe to the monthly E-newsletter. Your membership helps to preserve and revitalise this important part of Scottish culture, including the training of new teachers.
