#### Vale Margaret Sim & Kevin Connolly

It was with great sadness that the Scottish Country Dancing Community said farewell to two dedicated and influential members.

Margaret Sim passed away on 3rd August after a long illness. Margaret was not only a dedicated teacher, but an Honour Roll & Branch Award recipient.

Kevin Connolly passed away on 18th August in Tumut, NSW aged 90. Kevin was one of the first teacher examiners in Australia and was active in this role from 1976 until 1990. During the 1950's Kevin toured Europe and South Africa with Dr Milligan, demonstrating and promoting SCD.

We are so lucky to have had such dedicated people amongst us. Their legacy lives on in every class, workshop & social held & enjoyed by so many.
